

RBHS PTO Meeting

Held on Monday, March 6, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by our president, Mary Ellen Meindl.

OPENING CEREMONIES: We started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

He has gotten donations from other sources.

A motion was made to give Robert Dunn \$200.00 for his Eagle Scout project by Sandy Briolat. Second by Sondra Krumm-Carlson. Motion passes and is approved.

We have a grant request of \$1000.00 for the choreographer for the spring musical. We decided to table our discussion until we received more information.

BUSINESS ITEM:

We are amending our PTO bylaws so some officers can hold an office for 3 terms. A motion was made to amend the bylaws by Veronica Diaz. Second by Jane Wilhelm. Motion passes and is approved.
